

# Memorial Offerings

In an attempt to ensure that Masses at Queenship of Mary will be available when close family and friends of parishioners pass away, we would like to remind all parishioners of policies that have been in effect for a number of years, as well as inform you of several new ones.

## Memorial Mass Policies

*(for Masses celebrated at Queenship of Mary)*

Masses allocated per registered family:

Anniversary or other “past” Intentions	6
Masses for new deaths or intentions	8

Offered for one particular person’s death 10

## Mission Masses

*(Mass Intentions sent to the Diocesan Mission Office to be celebrated by Missionary Priests)*

Mission Mass – regular Mass	\$ 5
Mission Mass – annual enrollment – Book-type Mass card	\$20
<i>(these offerings are used to help the Missions continue their good works ~ the person the intention is requested for is prayed for daily.)</i>	
Mission Mass – perpetual enrollment – book-type Mass card	\$40

## Other Memorial Options

There are several reasons to request an offering be made in somebody’s name: for example, in thanksgiving, for the intentions of another person or, as is most common, for the repose of the soul of someone who has died. Other opportunities in the past at Queenship of Mary have included providing the Sanctuary flowers, vestments, and the red and blue votive candles.

Below is a list of the Memorial options that are now available at Queenship of Mary. A card is available to present to the families of those people for whom the intention is requested. These offerings will be listed in the parish bulletin.

Sanctuary Flowers	\$150
Votive candles	\$ 5
Sanctuary Lamp (one week)	\$ 25
<i>(the Sanctuary Lamp is burned continually as a sign of the continual real presence of Jesus Christ, Body, Blood, Soul and Divinity. This candle is burned at the tabernacle.)</i>	
Bread & Wine (one week)	\$ 20
<i>(the bread and wine used during the Sacrifice of each Mass for one week)</i>
